The Raytheon Company is a major American defense contractor and industrial corporation with core manufacturing concentrations in weapons and military and commercial electronics. It was previously involved in corporate and special-mission aircraft until early 2007. Raytheon is the world's largest producer of guided missiles.^[5]

Established in 1922, the company [reincorporated](#) in 1928 and adopted its present name in 1959. The company has around 63,000 employees worldwide^[6] and annual revenues of approximately US\$25 billion. More than 90% of Raytheon's revenues were obtained from military contracts and, as of 2012, it was the fifth-largest military contractor in the world,^[7] and is the fourth largest [defense contractor in the United States by revenue](#).

Raytheon's headquarters moved from [Lexington, Massachusetts](#), to [Waltham, Massachusetts](#), in 2003.^[8] The company was previously headquartered in [Cambridge, Massachusetts](#), from 1922 to 1928, [Newton, Massachusetts](#), from 1928 to 1941, Waltham from 1941 to 1961, Lexington from 1961 to 2003, and back to Waltham from 2003 onwards.

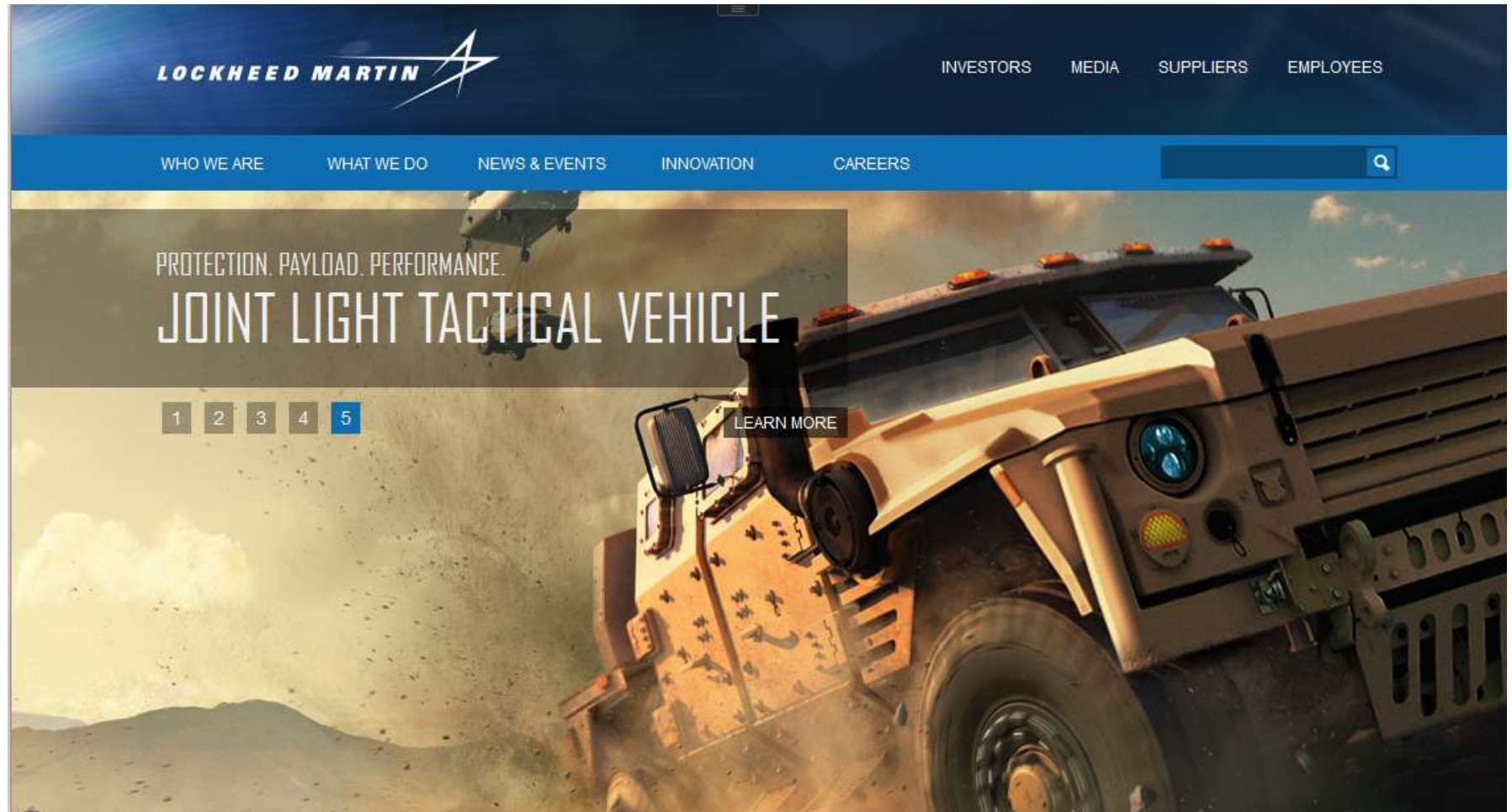

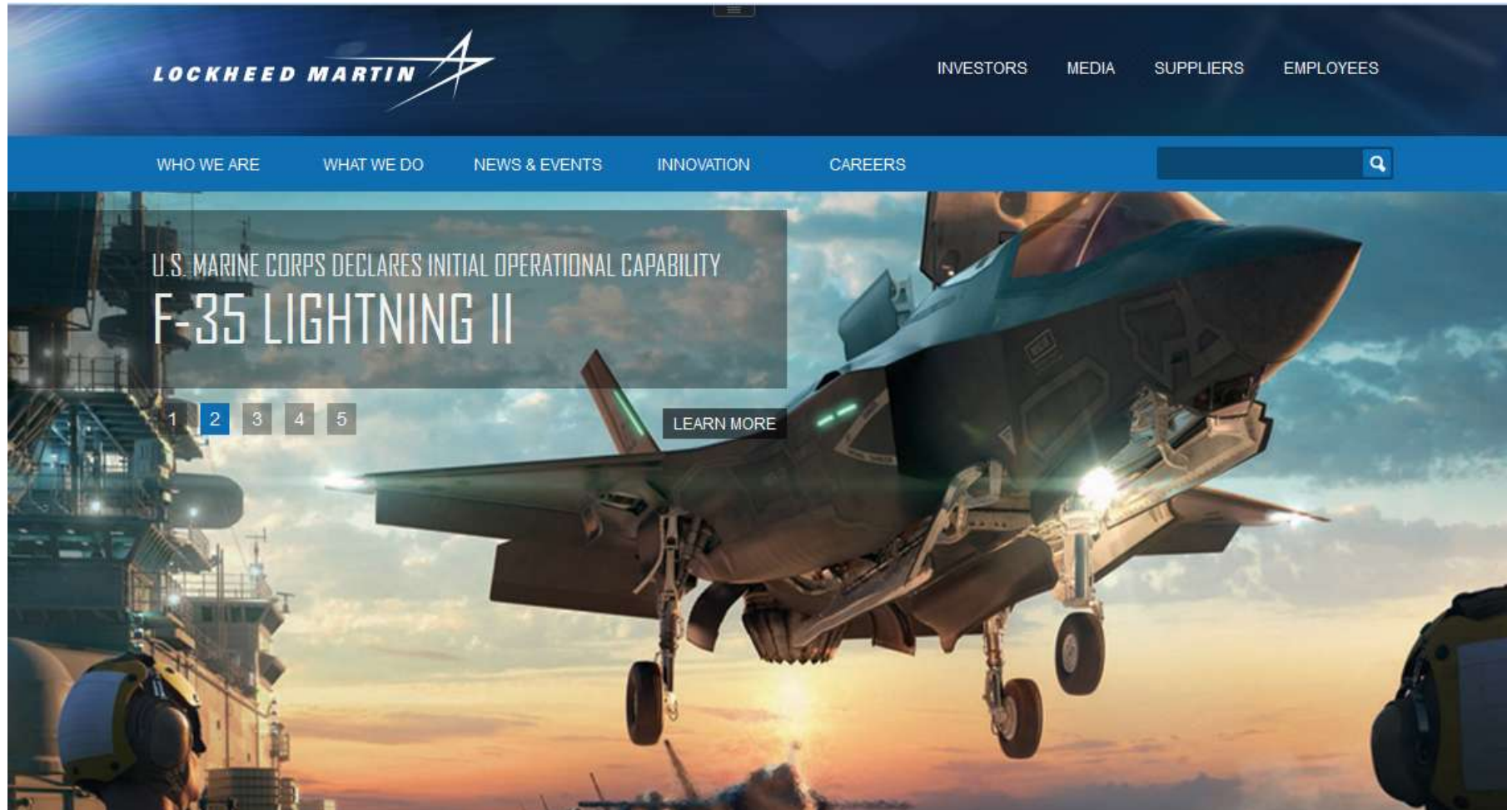

Armor Holdings was founded in 1969 as **American Body Armor and Equipment, Inc.**^[2] at Jacksonville, Florida. In January 1996 the company underwent a change in control; Kanders Florida Holdings, Inc. and others purchased the stock held by the company's two largest shareholders. The Armor Holdings, Inc. name was adopted on August 21, 1996.^[2]

It acquired Fairfield, Ohio-based **O'Gara-Hess & Eisenhardt** in 2001^[3] and renamed it **Centigon**.

In 2003, it acquired Simula, Inc. a developer and producer of **military** seating systems, the Cockpit **Air Bag** System (CABS) for US Army helicopters, the Small Arms Protective Insert (SAPI) armor system, and parachutes. Simula developed and produced the first **crashworthy** armored crew seats for the **US Army UH-60 Black Hawk** and **AH-64 Apache helicopters**.^[4]^[5]^[6]

On August 2, 2005, Armor Holdings acquired **Second Chance**, a **body armor** manufacturing company, for \$45 million.

In 2006, Armor Holdings obtained a \$649 million order for the U.S. Army to manufacture tactical vehicle trucks.^[7]



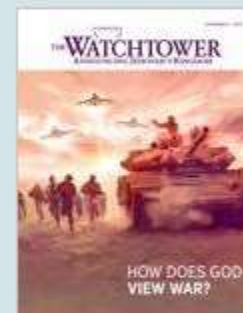
